

Information Notice pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of EU Regulation 679/2016

Joining the European Network of Comprehensive Cancer Centres entails the processing of information considered *personal data* under current legislation (EU Regulation 679/2016). Such data (name, role, email and telephone contacts, country, city) will be collected through the online completion of the form for an initial expression of interest and, possibly at a later stage, through documents that may be uploaded as attachments, such as for example:

- CCC Certificate issued by the certification body in PDF format.
- Document declaring the centre's eligibility for registration.

The data will be processed by specifically authorised personnel, and their provision is required for joining the European Network of Comprehensive Cancer Centres (including the expression of interest). The legal basis is Article 6, paragraph 1, letter b of EU Regulation 679/2016 (processing is necessary for the performance of a contract, including pre-contractual documentation).

Personal data: any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier, or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person (Art. 4, paragraph 1, EU Regulation 2016/679).
